Like previous year this year also the Higher Education Department Govt. of Assam will be extending monthly financial assistance to all the girls students of H.S. 1st and 2nd Year and FYUG 1st Year (1st & 2nd Sem) and 2nd Year (3rd & 4th Sem) and 3rd Year (5th & 6th Sem) and all the boys students of FYUG 1st Year (1st & 2nd Sem) and 2nd Year (3rd & 4th Sem) of Arts, Science and Commerce. Girls and Boys students will have to submit filled up form to the office of the Principal. The Central Programme of **Mukhya Mantrir Nijut Monia Scheme and Mukhya Mantrir Nijut Babu Scheme** will be done by the **Hon'ble Chief Minister of Assam, Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma and Hon'ble Education Minister of Assam, Dr. Ranaj Pegu on 6th of August, 2026** at Srimanta Sankardeva International Auditorium, Kalakshetra, Panjabari, Guwahati and the live streaming/telecasting of the programme will be arranged by the college on 06-08-2026. After the live streaming programme is over, the ceremonial MMNMA and MMNBA form will be distributed among the girls and boys students by the Chief Guest of the programme in our college, **Shri Kripanath Mallah, MP representing the Karimganj Constituency in the Lok Sabha & Rabindra Ch Deb, Chairman, Sribhumi Municipal Board** The programme will begin at **12:30 p.m.** in the **Pramesh Chandra Bhattacharjee Memorial Hall (Auditorium)**. This is extremely important for the Girl and Boy Students to remain present in the program as this program has been organized to ensure the fact that this Financial Assistance as Admission Incentive reaches the said Girl and Boy Students smoothly and without any hindrances.

The monthly financial assistance for girls students of HS is Rs. 800/- and for the FYUG students is 1250/- and for boys students of FYUG students is 1000/-

Also teachers are requested to remain present in said programme.

Eligibility Criteria for MMNBA:

- a) The incentive shall be applicable to male students domiciled in Assam, belonging to families with an annual income below Rs. 4.00 lakh and admitted under the Fee Waiver category.
- b) The student must be enrolled as a regular student in UG 1st and 2nd Years in a Government or Provincialised Institution.
- c) In the case of UG male students, those who are married shall not be eligible for the scheme.
- d) In the case of UG male students, those who have opted for the Dr. Banikanta Kakati Merit Award (Scooter) shall not be eligible for the scheme.
- e) Applicants must possess a valid Aadhaar number and must have an Aadhaar-seeded bank account, and this information must be submitted along with a signed consent & declaration form during the MMNBA application process. DBT will be done only through the Aadhaar-based payment system to the Aadhaar-seeded bank accounts of eligible girl students. No

applicant will be eligible to receive benefit under the Scheme without a valid Aadhaar number and an Aadhaar-seeded bank account.

f) Only male students, admitted under fee waiver scheme apply for the MMNBA. A valid income certificate from the competent authority or ration card of the parents of respective student is required for verification and upload.

g) Students who have not enrolled for the final examinations of the previous academic year shall also not be eligible to avail MMNBA benefits.

Eligibility Criteria for MMNMA

a) The student must be enrolled as a regular student in a Government or Provincialised Institution.

b) The incentive is meant for all eligible girl students domiciled in Assam, irrespective of their economic status.

c) Married girls will not be eligible for the scheme.

d) Daughters of Ministers, MPs and MLAs are not eligible for the Nijut Moina Scheme.

e) From the Academic Year 2027–28 onwards, girl students enrolled in H.S. and U.G. shall be eligible to avail only the Fee Waiver Scheme or the Mukhya Mantrir Nijut Moina Aasoni. Beneficiaries shall not be eligible to avail both schemes.

f) Applicants must possess a valid Aadhaar number and must have an Aadhaar-seeded bank account, and this information must be submitted by the students to the Institution along with a signed consent & declaration form during the MMNMA application process. DBT will be done only through the Aadhaar-based payment system to the Aadhaar-seeded bank accounts of eligible girl students. No applicant will be eligible to receive benefit under the Scheme without a valid Aadhaar number and an Aadhaar-seeded bank account.

g) Students who have not enrolled for the final examinations of the previous academic year shall also not be eligible to avail MMNMA benefits.
